

## Advisory Notice / Commercial Shipments / Aug 20

Dear,

Please be advised that, effective **August 29**, the U.S. government will **suspend the duty-free de minimis exemption** for low-value imports (shipments valued at or under \$800) entering the country.

This policy change, enacted by Executive Order from the Trump administration, means that **all commercial shipments—regardless of value—will now require formal customs clearance** and will be subject to **applicable duties and inspections**, even if the item is valued at just **\$1**.

## What This Means for You

If your business currently ships goods to the U.S. under the \$800 threshold to avoid formal customs procedures:

- That exemption will **no longer apply**.
- **Formal customs clearance will be required for all commercial shipments, regardless of value.**
- Duties and taxes will apply based on product classification and country of origin.
- Low value de minimus entry processes are no longer valid for commercial shipments.
- Failure to comply may result in delays, penalties, or seizure of goods.
